## DESTINATION PORTLAND Transportation Subsidy Application

To help defray the cost of bus transportation to arts/cultural events, Portland Ovation is offering transportation subsidies to Lewiston/Auburn and York County schools. The subsidy supports field trips occurring between January 1, 2010 and May 30, 2010. Schools or districts will be reimbursed for bus transportation up to \$500. One grant is available per school. Grant money covers only transportation costs. Tickets or admission fees to arts/cultural institutions are separate costs. Grants are offered on a first-come, first-served basis.\*
